How do I become a part of "TEAM NSW" at ATBSO Nationals???

A bowling TIP from the COACH!

With the thumb up on your non-bowling arm's hand, your shoulders want to close throughout the bowling approach, and this creates pulled shots and other inconsistencies. With the thumb facing down on your non-bowling arm's hand, your shoulders stay open longer, allowing the bowling swing to naturally flow throughout the bowling approach.

When your shoulders are stable throughout the bowling approach your accuracy and balance increase, which leads to more consistent shots!
