# Your FEEDBACK was greatly appreciated:



#### **Open Door Policy:**



# **Monthly Coaching Tips:**

REV's: A **revolution**, or **rev**, is one complete turn or rotation of a round object on its axis – 360 degrees equals one revolution. The more revolutions a bowler imparts to a bowling ball, decreases the skid, creating earlier roll.



<u>How Rev's are created:</u> There is a direct correlation between the hand position at the point of release and the number of revolutions an athlete may potentially impart to the ball. The further the fingers are under the equator of the ball, the longer the fingers remain in the ball, creating more revolutions.
